## Health and safety instructions to enjoy a safe ski season

Basic sanitary measures











The <u>vaccine passport</u> will be required for people aged 13 and over for the use of the ski lifts and the access of certain services in the ski lodge. Be ready to show your vaccine passport and your photo ID at your arrival at the ski area.

| Ski lodge   | The face covering is mandatory inside the ski lodge for people aged 10 and over. The venue capacity is limited to 50 %. The 1 meter physical distancing between people who do not live together must be respected. The use of the lodge as a shelter for guests is permitted to warm up, with limited access time. Access to the toilets is permitted. |
| Restaurants, bars<br>and lunch areas                      | Restaurants, bars and lunch areas are closed. Takeout only, consumption outside mandatory.   |
| Services (ski shop, rentals, lockers)                     | The face covering is mandatory in the indoor spaces for people aged 10 and over. The venue capacity is limited to 50 %. The 1 meter physical distancing between people who do not live together must be respected.   |
| Ski lifts   | Visitors from the same household are encouraged to ride the lift together. In the lift lines and while riding the lift, the face-covering* is recommended. Inside the gondolas, 6 people or visitors from the same household are permitted and the face covering* is mandatory.  *It can be a balaclava or neck warmer covering both mouth and nose.   |
| Skiing and<br>snowboarding<br>schools and racing<br>clubs | Ski and snowboard lessons as well as racing club activities are permitted. The face covering* is recommended. *It can be a balaclava or neck warmer covering both mouth and nose.  |
